SERMON

This morning's sermon discusses the importance of spiritual gifts within the Christian community, emphasizing their diversity and unity of purpose. It highlights that the Holy Spirit gives these gifts for the common good and should be used to build up the body of Christ.

 \cdot Spiritual gifts come from the same Spirit, Lord, and God.

 \cdot Each gift serves a unique purpose and contributes to the church's overall health and mission.

The diversity of gifts is a blessing, not a hindrance.

 \cdot Each gift complements others, creating a harmonious and effective ministry.

 \cdot Gifts are for serving others and advancing God's kingdom, not for personal glory.

The church, like a physical body, requires cooperation among its parts.

 \cdot When one member suffers or rejoices, the whole body is affected.

 \cdot This interconnectedness calls for support and encouragement among members.

The Holy Spirit distributes gifts according to His will.

 \cdot Spiritual gifts are graciously given, not earned.

 \cdot Being attuned to the Holy Spirit is essential for discovering and developing gifts.
