SERMON Rev. Ken Goodrich

Sunday of Peace, we reflect on two passages that offer hope, peace, and assurance amid life's challenges. Isaiah 9:6-7 and John 16:32-33 highlight God's promises and the peace Jesus brings to our lives.

- · Isaiah prophesied during a time of turmoil and darkness for Israel.
- · He spoke of a child, Jesus, who would bring salvation and peace.
- · Jesus is given four titles: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace.
 - · These titles reveal different aspects of Jesus' character and mission.
- $\cdot \ Is a iah's \ prophecy \ speaks \ of \ an \ eternal \ kingdom \ established \ on \ justice \ and \ righteousness, \ ruled \ by \ Jesus.$
 - · Jesus spoke to His disciples the night before His crucifixion, preparing them for imminent challenges.
 - · He acknowledged that life is filled with troubles and hardships.
 - · Despite these troubles, Jesus offers His peace, which is rooted in our relationship with Him.
 - · This peace transcends circumstances and is a gift available to all who trust in Him.
 - · Jesus assures us of His victory over the world, giving us confidence and hope.
